Addendum No. 1

The following items have been modified, clarified, added to, or deleted from the project and are hereby issued as an addendum to the plans and specifications for said project:

Page 41 Bid Proposal Form: The Bidder shall insert the amount \$25,000 as the fixed amount in bid schedule line item number 31, Allowance for Owner Directed Changes, in both the “Bid Unit Price” box and in the “Total Extended Bid Price” box. All Bids shall contain the amount of \$25,000 as the fixed amount for Allowance for Owner Directed Changes.

Page 68 General Conditions – Police Officer Hours: Police Officer hours are to be provided as set forth in this section. The installation of the storm sewer pipe in Sacaton Street and the construction of the sidewalk and valley drain crossings for Top & Bottom Street are the only locations where lane closures may require police presence as determined by the City Engineer. The Bidder shall include in the bid price for bid schedule line item number 30, Traffic Control, an allowance of \$4,000 to cover any and all police officer time and expense that may be required. The Contractor shall furnish receipts for all police time and expenses paid and provide a credit for actual costs less than the allowance of \$4,000 and shall be paid an additional amount for any costs exceeding the \$4,000 allowance. The \$4,000 allowance shall be built into the total bid lump sum price and total extended bid lump sum price for Traffic Control.

Page 79 Wage Decision: The Bidder shall pay wages as set forth in this wage decision and each bidder is responsible for determining the correct wage rates to pay employees on the project for the classifications of work actually being performed. HUD is the determining agency for enforcing wages paid on this contract. The Bidder needs to comply with all applicable federal rules and regulations per the Contract Documents and the Wage Rate Decision.

Acknowledgement: Each Bidder shall acknowledge receipt of this Addendum in their bid package.

Each and every bidder, firm, contractor, subcontractor, or supplier shall be responsible for reading each and every item in this addendum to ascertain to what extent and in what manner it affects the work that they are interested in.
