WHEREAS, trees will continue to provide the community with colors, flowers, and beautiful landscapes that can be enjoyed by all citizens; and


WHEREAS, our community trees must be perpetuated to provide the benefits of aesthetics, shade, energy conservation, noise reduction, carbon storage and community livability; and


WHEREAS, the climate and special beauty of the Desert Southwest are valuable resources enjoyed by many, and should be taken care of for the sake of our children and our children's children; and
