***“Brain Injury Awareness Month – March 2016”***

**WHEREAS**, brain injury is a public health concern that impacts a reported 1.7 million people in the United States annually; and

**WHEREAS**, 80,000 to 90,000 of these individuals sustain permanent disability; and

**WHEREAS**, in Arizona there were a reported 1,317 deaths, 6,690 Hospitalizations, and 47,395 Emergency Department Visits in 2011 resulting in over \$692.4 million in hospital charges due to Traumatic Brain Injury; and

**WHEREAS**, education and awareness are key to the prevention of treatment of brain injury; and

**WHEREAS**, The Brain Injury Alliance of Arizona (BIAAZ) is a nonprofit organization dedicated to preventing brain injuries and to improving the lives of individuals with brain injuries through prevention, education, information, and community support; and

**NOW, THEREFORE**, I, Robert M. Jackson, Mayor of the City of Casa Grande, do hereby proclaim **MARCH 2016**, as **“BRAIN INJURY AWARENESS MONTH,”** in Casa Grande, Arizona.
