The Casa Grande Arts & Humanities Commission (AHC) recognizes individuals in the Casa Grande Community that have made arts and culture a vital part of the community by awarding the Bravo Award. Recipient of the 2015 Bravo Award will be honored on a date and at a location to be determined.

Eligibility:

Individuals selected by the Commission to receive the Bravo Award must have made a substantial contribution to the arts in Casa Grande and meet **one** of the following criteria:

- ✓ Served in leadership role in arts organization
- ✓ Created art, art programs/projects, or an organization that has had a positive impact on the art and culture of the City of Casa Grande
- ✓ Work has spurred additional creative endeavors within the City of Casa Grande

Individuals selected by the Commission to receive the Bravo Award must have made a substantial contribution to the arts in Casa Grande and meet **all** of the following criteria:

- ✓ Eligible candidates can be artists, patrons, supporters, teachers, authors, and appreciators of the arts
- ✓ Has not already received the Bravo Award
- ✓ Candidate must be 18 years or older.
- ✓ Current members of Arts & Humanities Commission are not eligible for this award.
