Casa Grande Receives "Best Master Plan" Award for Life on Main Master Plan

The City of Casa Grande received a "Best Master Plan" award by the Arizona Chapter of the American Planning Association for the Life on Main Master Plan in downtown Casa Grande.

The Life on Main Master Plan provides a blue print for developing approximately 15 acres of vacant land that the City owns south of the Union Pacific Railroad in downtown Casa Grande. The City worked closely with Matrix Design Group to develop the Master Plan, which was approved by the Casa Grande City Council in August 2013.

The Master Plan is the result of a year-long planning process that included input from several meetings with the public, community stakeholders, and city officials. The Master Plan will help guide development in the area to attract more businesses, residents and an overall sense of vibrant downtown community.

Next Municipal Election in 2016

The City of Casa Grande will hold its next municipal election in August and November of 2016, a change that was made to comply with the City's charter and changes in state law.

Under its charter and in accordance with state law at the time, Casa Grande has traditionally held municipal elections in odd-numbered years, with the primary in March and general election in May. The next election in this cycle would normally be in March and May of 2015. Beginning with elections held in 2014, however, state law now requires all municipalities to hold local elections on the same schedule as those for statewide offices, in August and November of even-numbered years.

Due to the change in state law and pursuant to the City's charter, the terms of the Mayor and Council Members whose terms would ordinarily expire in 2015 or 2017 must now be extended until their successors are elected in 2016 or 2018.

Those interested in running for Mayor or a seat on the City Council in the 2016 election will be required to file a candidate packet with the City Clerk three months before the primary election. To learn more about the election process, contact the City Clerk at (520) 421-8608.

The open house is co-sponsored by the Friends of the Casa Grande Public Library, who donated \$50,000 toward new furniture at the Main Library.


