



## Tractor Supply Company Coming to Casa Grande

Tractor Supply Company has selected Casa Grande as the site of its first western distribution center. The Tennessee-based company plans on opening a new 640,000-square-foot distribution center on about 100 acres in the Central Arizona Commerce Park near Peters and Burris Roads. The company plans on hiring over 200 employees when they open in 2015.

The \$100 million Casa Grande distribution center will deliver merchandise to stores in Arizona, Nevada, Utah, southern California and New Mexico.

The Fortune 500 company also plans on opening a retail store in Casa Grande on Florence Blvd.

Tractor Supply is the largest retail farm and ranch supply store chain in the United States with more than 1,300 stores in 48 states.

## Casa Grande Receives National Award for Redesigned Website

The City of Casa Grande received an Award of Excellence by the national City-County Communications & Marketing Association (3CMA) for its redesigned website, [www.casagrandeaz.gov](http://www.casagrandeaz.gov). Casa Grande was one of three winners in the category of Digital Interactive - Overall Website. Over 600 entries in 37 categories were submitted from across the country in this year's 3CMA awards competition.



The City launched its redesigned website in July 2013. The new website was designed entirely in-house by the City's webmaster using WordPress, an open-source content management system (CMS). Some of the new features of the website include live video streaming of council meetings and a "How do I" tab to take visitors directly to job openings, pay city utility bill, report graffiti and much more.

"Love the simple format of the homepage," said the judges. "Makes a great argument for use of Wordpress as a CMS, versus expensive third party software."

3CMA awards recognize skilled and effective city, county, agency or district professionals who have creatively planned and carried out successful innovations in communications and marketing.


