RESOLUTION NO. 3461

A RESOLUTION OF THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF CASA GRANDE, ARIZONA, DESIGNATING THE EVERGREEN FIRST ADDITION AS A LOCAL HISTORIC DISTRICT; AND AUTHORIZING THE CITY CLERK TO RECORD ALL DOCUMENTS NECESSARY TO EFFECUATE THIS RESOLUTION WITH THE PINAL COUNTY RECORDERS OFFICE.

WHEREAS, the City Council has determined that the protection, enhancement and perpetuation of historic districts is necessary to promote the economic, cultural, educational and general welfare of the public; and

WHEREAS, the City Council has determined that the identity of a people is founded on its past, and that historic architectural and cultural resources constitute a people's heritage, which can best be perpetuated by preserving and protecting these resources.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF CASA GRANDE, PINAL COUNTY, ARIZONA, as follows:

Section 1: That all lots described within the documents marked Exhibit "A", attached hereto and made a part hereof, are hereby declared to be within and part of the Evergreen First Addition Historic District pursuant to the provisions of Section 17.62.010 and 17.62.050, Casa Grande Municipal Code.

Section 2: That the City Clerk record this Resolution and Exhibit A attached hereto and made a part hereof in the Office of the Pinal County Recorder, Pinal County, Arizona.
