

A pick-up request must be made no later than 4 p.m. on the Friday before the scheduled collection week. ## Bag & Tie To Reduce Odors, Fly Breeding



Please bag and tie your garbage and grass clippings to reduce fly breeding, unsanitary conditions and spillage of materials from containers and sanitation trucks on roadways.

In addition to using standard garbage bags, plastic grocery bags are an easy and economical way to secure perishable household items.

# 2017 Trash & Recycling Information

## Uncontained Trash Collection

**Definition:** Uncontained trash is waste that cannot be reasonably placed inside your curbside or alley trash container. Uncontained trash includes discarded furniture, mattresses, carpet, appliances (with Freon removed) and other bulky items too large for the container.

**Schedule:** The City collects residential uncontained trash every six weeks based on designated collection zone (see map and schedule on back).

- Residents wishing to have uncontained trash collected any time other than the established collection zone schedule, may schedule a special pickup for a fee of \$60 per half hour. Residents may also deliver the uncontained trash directly to the landfill during operating hours for no additional fee with proof of residency.

### Requirements for Collection:

- Place uncontained trash on your side of the alley, no earlier than one week prior to the scheduled collection week, but before 6:00 a.m. on Monday of the scheduled week.
- Residents with curbside service are requested to place uncontained trash no earlier than the weekend before the scheduled collection week, and must contact the Public Works Department the Friday before collection before 4:00 p.m. to schedule pickup. Trash must to be placed before 6:00 a.m. on Monday to assure collection.
- Recommended trash pile size limit is 10 cubic yards. This is equivalent to pile dimensions of 6 ft x 6 ft x 7.5 ft, or approximately three pickup truck loads.
- Do not place uncontained trash within three feet of City owned containers, water or gas meters, cable boxes or other fixed objects.
- Do not include tires, glass, shower doors, fluorescent lights or heavy construction materials in trash piles placed for collection.
- Do not include hazardous materials or Freon (refrigerants) in appliances.

## Resident Responsibilities & Trash Service Options

- Residents are responsible for keeping trash and recycling containers clean, and maintained in a secured area.
- Residents with an alley are responsible for trimming trees or shrubbery on their property and in the adjacent right-of-way when such vegetation interferes with the safe movement of solid waste collection vehicles and collection of uncontained trash in the alley.
- Residents with an alley are responsible for maintaining the alley behind the property to ensure it is free of litter and trash up to the center line of the alley. The exception is for the placement of uncontained trash in the alley for scheduled zone collection.
- Residents are requested to Bag & Tie garbage grass clippings to reduce fly breeding, unsanitary conditions and spillage of materials from containers and sanitation trucks on roadways.
- Residents can report broken, cracked or damaged trash and recycling containers for repair or replacement. Up to five recycling containers per household may be requested for no additional fee. A recycle drop-off center is also available to residents at the landfill during regular landfill hours of operation (Monday – Saturday, 7:00 a.m. – 4:00 p.m.).
- Residents with curbside service may request a second or additional trash container to be serviced for an additional \$11 per month. There is also a one-time container purchase and delivery fee of \$82.

## Waste Tire Recycling Drop-Off Center 12725 Adamsville Road, Florence

Pinal County Material Recovery Center accepts waste tires. There is no charge to Pinal County residents for up to five automobile tires (with or without rims), per resident. Additional automobile tires are charged a fee of \$1.00 per tire; additional tires with rims are \$5.00 per tire. Off-Road tires are \$5.00 per tire. ## Tips to Assure Curbside Container Collection

- Place container at the curb (in street) by 6:00 a.m. on your scheduled collection day. Time of actual collection may change at any time without notice. Sanitation trucks are electronically tracked to assure service has been provided on your street. Drivers do not return to pickup missed containers placed out after 6:00 a.m.
- Place container at least three feet from parked cars and stationary objects as mail boxes and light poles. Drivers do not exit trucks to move containers due to safety and operational concerns.
- Make sure container lids are closed and container is not over filled with protruding items or overweight when placed for collection. Residents are requested to Bag & Tie garbage and grass clippings. Drivers are not responsible for cleaning up spilled trash resulting from overfilled containers.

## Casa Grande Landfill 5200 S. Chuichu Road, Casa Grande



Monday - Saturday (7:00 a.m. - 4:00 p.m.)  
Closed Sundays & City observed holidays

Residents disposing of household waste must provide a driver's license and proof of residency to avoid paying landfill fees.

The following materials are not accepted at the landfill: medical sharps, tires, hazardous waste, motor oil, flammable

materials or gases and appliances with cooling elements where refrigerant has not been removed.

The landfill serves as a recycling drop-off facility for E-waste (electronic devices\*), fluorescent light bulbs, scrap metal, and latex-water based paint. These materials must not be placed for collection in the residential recycling bins.

\*cathode ray tubes (CRTs) are not accepted for recycling
