

Residents disposing of household waste must provide a driver's license and proof of residency to avoid paying landfill fees.

The following materials are not accepted at the landfill: tires, hazardous waste, motor oil, antifreeze, bulk liquids, automobiles, asbestos, petroleum contaminated soil and flammable materials or gasses.

Please Note:

The landfill serves as a recycling drop-off facility for E-waste (electronic devices*): fluorescent light bulbs, scrap metal, and latex-water based paint. These materials should not be placed for collection in the residential recycling bins.

* cathode ray tubes (CRTs) are not accepted for recycling

Reasons Your Trash May NOT Be Picked Up:



1. The container was not placed at the curb by 6:00 a.m. on your collection day.
2. The container was blocked by a vehicle parked in front or behind it, or placed too close to a stationary object like a mailbox or by a fence.
3. The container was overflowing or overweight.

Bag & Tie To Reduce Odors, Fly Breeding

Please bag & tie your garbage and grass clippings to reduce fly breeding, unsanitary conditions and spillage of materials from containers and sanitation trucks on roadways.



In addition to using

standard garbage bags, plastic grocery bags are an easy and economical way to secure perishable household items.

Pinal County Material Recovery Center accepts waste tires. There is no charge to Pinal County residents for up to five automobile tires (with or without rims) per resident. Additional automobile tires are charged a fee of \$1.00 per tire. The cost to dispose of Off Road tires is \$5.00 per tire. The cost is \$2.00 per tire for Semi-trailer truck tires.

Uncontained Trash Information

2014 Map & Schedule on Back

Uncontained trash is anything that is not considered household waste, such as tree limbs, bagged lawn clippings, discarded appliances, furniture, mattresses, carpet and other bulky items too large for placement in the trash container. These materials may also be delivered to the landfill regardless of zone collection schedule. All other household trash must be placed in the trash container for collection.

Residents with curbside pick up must call (520) 421-8625 or visit the city website www.casagrandeaz.gov (service request) the week before zone collection date to schedule curbside pick up.

Residents with alleys do not need to call for a pickup.

- Place uncontained trash for collection the weekend before the scheduled collection week. (Schedule on Back).
- Trash must be placed before 6:00 a.m. on the first day of the collection week to assure collection.
- Bag and tie or box leaves and grass clippings.
- Cut tree trimmings over 5 feet in length.
- No tires, heavy construction materials, glass windows, shower doors, mirrors or fluorescent light tubes.
- No hazardous materials.
- No appliances with Freon--refrigerants (\$20 Freon removal fee if required).
