

Residents with curbside service must contact the Public Works Department at (520) 421-8625 or www.casagrandeaz.gov (select "Service Request") to schedule a pick up no later than 4 p.m. on the Friday before the scheduled collection week. UNCONTAINED TRASH COLLECTION

2016 MAP & SCHEDULE ON BACK

Uncontained trash is waste that cannot be reasonably placed in your trash container. Uncontained trash includes discarded furniture, mattresses, carpet, appliances (with Freon removed) and other bulky items too large for the trash container.

The City collects uncontained trash every six weeks from residential customers based on location or collection zone (schedule on back). Residents may also request out-of-zone collections at any time (special pickup fee of \$60 per half hour), or deliver uncontained trash directly to the landfill for no additional charge at any time during landfill operating hours, regardless of collection zone schedule.

In order to provide safe and cost-effective collection of uncontained trash, it is recommended that residents do the following:

- Place trash at least four feet from city owned containers, water or gas meters, cable boxes or other fixed objects.
- Limit trash pile size to 10 cubic yards. This is equivalent to pile dimensions of 6 ft x 6 ft x 7.5 ft, or approx. three pickup truck loads.
- Do not include tires, glass, shower doors, fluorescent lights or heavy construction materials in trash piles placed for collection.
- Do not include hazardous materials or Freon (refrigerants) in appliances.

Please place uncontained trash on your side of the alley, no earlier than one week prior to your scheduled collection week, but before 6 a.m. of the first day of the scheduled week. Residents with curbside service should not place trash for collection prior to the weekend before the scheduled collection week, and must contact the Public Works Department to schedule the pick up. Residents disposing of household waste must provide a driver's license and proof of residency to avoid paying landfill fees.

The following materials are not accepted at the landfill: sharps, tires, hazardous waste, motor oil, flammable materials or gases and appliances with cooling elements where refrigerant has not been removed.

Please Note:

The landfill serves as a recycling drop-off facility for E-waste (electronic devices*), fluorescent light bulbs, scrap metal, and latex-water based paint. These materials should not be placed for collection in the residential recycling bins.

* cathode ray tubes (CRTs) are not accepted for recycling

Reasons Your
Trash May NOT
Be Picked Up:



1. The container was not placed at the curb by 6:00 a.m. on your collection day.
2. The container was blocked by a vehicle parked in front or behind it, or placed too close to a stationary object like a mailbox or by a fence.
3. The container was overflowing or overweight.

As a reminder, owners or occupants of properties are responsible for trimming or removing all vegetation that interferes with the movement of solid waste collection vehicles through the alley right-of-way (City Code Section 8.08.180.B.) Please help assure safe trash collection service by maintaining vegetative growth in and into the alley behind your property.
