INTERSTATE 10/KORTSEN ROAD TRAFFIC INTERCHANGE

The City of Casa Grande is studying a proposal for a new traffic interchange within the study area shown in the map. The purpose of the new traffic interchange will be to address projected increases in traffic resulting from increasing population growth, residential development, and business development including Phoenix Mart. The City's study will evaluate the potential impact of this anticipated growth and development, and propose alternatives to help address the increasing traffic to and from Interstate 10 in the Florence Boulevard corridor and in eastern Casa Grande.

The City of Casa Grande is hosting a public open house on Wednesday, July 23, 2014 from 5:30 p.m. to 7:00 p.m. at the City Council Chamber located at 510 E. Florence Boulevard to share information and gather your comments on a proposed traffic interchange along Interstate 10. 
