Road/street improvements
Flood and drainage improvements
Solid waste disposal facilities and equipment
Wastewater system improvements
Water system improvements
Other Public or Private owned utilities
Fire and Police Protection Facilities
Fire/police station construction
Fire trucks
Firefighting equipment
ADA/ROB Accessibility Improvements for Fire/Police station facilities
Community/Supportive Housing Facilities
DA/ROB improvements as a standalone activity for any community/supportive housing facility (including parks, playgrounds etc., and libraries, youth center, community centers etc.)
Parls, Playgrounds and other Recreational Facilities (for use by local residents)
Libraries
Community Facilities (e.g. Community Center, Sr. Center)
Other Neighborhood facility (e.g. youth center, Library)
Senior Centers
Social service centers
Food banks
Physical or psychological disabilities facilities
Homeless facilities
Supportive housing facilities (DV shelters, halfway houses, housing for disaster victims, hospitals, etc.)

Economic Development (tied with job creation or retention)
Direct assistance to for-profits (businesses)
Economic development services
Micro-enterprise assistance (businesses)

Acquisition, disposition, clearance, or demolition of real property (specific criteria apply)
Commercial/industrial rehabilitation
Planning and Capacity Building
Comprehensive Plans
Community development plans
Housing plans and other such functional plans in certain areas (land use, transportation, historic preservations, etc.)
Neighborhood revitalization strategy
Policy, planning, management, and capacity building activities
